## Building the Future Campaign

### Board Approves Three Million Dollar Master Plan

The Middle Tennessee School of Anesthesia Board of Trustees approved a \$3.0 million master plan which includes the current new classroom/teaching theatre, in addition to other major building components, announced Nevin Downs, M.D., chairman. The meeting was held January 19 and the action was unanimous.

"We are very excited about the current direction of our master plan and building program," says Phil Hunt, president. "We have considered many options for the school's physical plant, including but not limited to relocation. The project of which we are pursuing currently allows us to meet all the growth needs of the school while being good fiscal stewards of the financial resources entrusted to our care. In fact," continues Hunt, "the current master plan provides for our needs today, in addition to accommodating future growth." (See adjoining article outlining each phase)

With the opportunity for growth comes the responsibility to fund it. MTSA has been very blessed to fund the recent purchase of the current land and buildings from Tennessee Christian Medical Center by using its cash reserves. Now the opportunity is ours as we seek participation, involvement and financial support from our contributing friends, family and others to completely fund the master plan - "Building the Future Campaign."

The MTSA Advancement Committee has met twice and is actively in process of engaging leadership for the "Building the Future Campaign." This \$3.0 million effort will fund the Master Plan, positioning MTSA as one of the nation's leaders in nurse anesthesia education.

"You will be seeing and hearing more about this campaign in the weeks and months ahead," said Hunt. "Opportunity for your participation will help fulfill the academic aspirations of hundreds and thousands of students for years to come."

"MTSA has grown enormously these last two-three years. It's not been growth for growth sake - we are simply responding to a massive market driven demand to provide quality Christian anesthesia education in the region. If MTSA did not respond - other universities in the area were ready to step up and do it. As the second largest CRNA school in the country, I'm pleased MTSA continues to be a leader in anesthesia education - producing unparalleled graduates with the leadership and clinical skills to provide excellent service."
